MAIN AGENDA

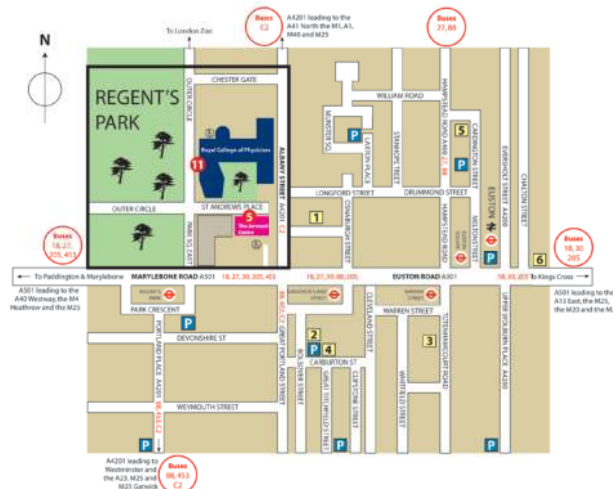
